The Animal Rights Alliance, Inc. has been spaying and neutering in our mobile clinic since 2002. We have performed approximately 115,000 surgeries, to date. We perform an average of 40 to 60 surgeries per day.

Requirements:

Must be a DVM or equivalent, a skilled surgeon with five to seven years' experience in high quality, high volume, spay/neuter surgeries and techniques, including pediatric, cryptorchid, third- trimester pregnancies and in heat, with an emphasis on quality patient care. We are looking for someone to work in our stationary clinic performing spay neuter surgeries primarily on canine patients. Good teamwork abilities and a strong desire to make a difference for the welfare of animals.

We are a non-profit organization located in Orange county, N.Y. committed to ending the euthanasia of healthy, adoptable animals in our community through targeted, high quality, high volume, low-cost, spay/neuter. We also provide pre-operative wellness and basic medical care, day of surgery.

Euthanasia is the number one killer of healthy animals and preventable.
